


- 1. You should always have two ways to get out of your room.
- 2. Mark your one safe meeting place on your escape plan. It should be outside your home, e.g. your letter box.
- 3. Put your escape plan somewhere everyone can see it, the fridge is a great place.
- 4. If you have a friend staying over for the first time, show them your escape plan so they know what to do in a fire emergency. Make sure they know where your safe meeting place is.






- Draw a fire plan of your house.
